

Standing Rules Governing Invited Guests at Meetings of the Board of Directors, Republican Club of Sun City Texas (RCSC)

I. Purpose and Scope

The Board of Directors may permit RCSC members in good standing and other invited guests to attend its meetings for the purpose of promoting transparency and member awareness.

Attendance by any non-Board member is a privilege, not a right, and is granted solely for observation, subject to the rules below and the Board's discretion.

II. Access

No person may attend a Board meeting as a guest without prior approval from the President, or, in the President's absence, the presiding officer (the Chair).

III. Participation and Rights

Guests are present only to observe. Guests have:

- No right to speak, debate, or make motions
- No voting rights
- No right to inspect or copy Board documents or materials without express permission of the Chair

IV. Decorum and Conduct

Every guest shall:

- Arrive on time and remain in the designated guest seating area until the meeting is adjourned or the guest is excused.
- Refrain from side conversations, movement about the room, or any other distracting behavior.
- Remain silent unless specifically invited to speak by the Chair.
- Not interrupt, interject, or otherwise disrupt discussion or voting.

V. Confidentiality and Recording

Guests shall not disclose, distribute, publish, or otherwise share:

- Any confidential or sensitive information learned at the meeting, or any information the Chair designates as sensitive during the meeting.
- Guests must leave the room during any Executive Session or portion of the meeting designated by the Chair as confidential.
- Audio, video, photographs, or live transcription of any portion of the meeting are prohibited without express permission of the Chair.

VI. Enforcement

The Chair has full authority to:

- Warn or immediately remove any guest who violates these rules or otherwise disrupts the meeting.
- Suspend or permanently revoke the future attendance privileges of any guest who violates these rules.

Decisions of the Chair under this section are final and not subject to appeal at the meeting.

VII. Adoption, Amendment, and Suspension

These Standing Rules may be adopted, amended, or suspended by a majority vote of the Board members present at any regular or special meeting of the Board.
