7:00 **Keynote Speaker** **Dustin Burrows** introduced by 1st VP of programs **Chris Alexander**

Introduced Terry Wilson, House Representative 20 and acclaimed his value as a member of the Texas House. His position as the Chair of Higher Education will affect faculty tenures if professors cannot follow state law.

Listed reasons why people and companies are moving to Texas.

- Texas Regulatory Commission for its business-friendly lack of regulations found in other states.
- Education system removing DEI, giving parental school choice, increasing teacher pay, fostering student and teacher discipline. Classes designed to teach financial literacy and credit card debt.
- Technical Education providing skilled workforce of plumbers, HVAC, technicians for future
